Cost of Advisory Services

For insurance, the commission may be paid by the insurance provider. Further advice that includes portfolio reviews may be charged on a percentage fee basis which varies according to the portfolio amount, or as a fixed dollar

amount depending on the complexity and structure, as agreed with your adviser.
